Policy on use of the “ummstudents” all-student e-mail list.

The “ummstudents” list is for messages that are of interest to the student body but do not meet the “ummofficial” criteria. The University of Minnesota, Morris values the free exchange of ideas; however, the list is moderated and messages that do not comply with the rules given below will be rejected.

- ⤴ E-mails must potentially apply to all currently enrolled students and serve an academic, administrative, or social function that relates to some aspect of the University and the University community of students.
- ⤴ E-mails must comply with the campus policy on ethical computing (<http://www.morris.umn.edu/cs/policies/ethics.html>).
- ⤴ E-mails must be sent from an official “umn.edu” email address.
- ⤴ E-mails must not be more appropriately directed to other resources (Zimrides for rideshares, [bookexchange.umn.edu](http://bookexchange.umn.edu) for buying or selling textbooks, etc.)
- ⤴ E-mails must not violate the Minnesota Board of Regents Student Conduct Code ([http://www1.umn.edu/regents/policies/academic/Student\\_Conduct\\_Code.html](http://www1.umn.edu/regents/policies/academic/Student_Conduct_Code.html)).

The entire student body is placed on this list at the beginning of each semester. Students may then opt out of the list if they choose by emailing [listserv@lists.umn.edu](mailto:listserv@lists.umn.edu) containing the message: **unsubscribe ummstudents**.
